Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with the permission to approach respondent No. 3-Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, for the reliefs claimed in the present petition, through a comprehensive representation/legal notice.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

If any such representation/legal notice, the liberty of which has been sought and got, is made by the petitioner, respondent No. 3-Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, is directed to take a decision thereupon expeditiously but not later than four months from the date of receipt of such representation/legal notice by passing a well reasoned and speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
