1. The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia* seeking a mandamus directing the respondents not to demolish the dwelling houses of the inhabitants of Shivalya Colony. Further a writ of certiorari has been sought for quashing the show-cause notices dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-13).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in pursuance to the show-cause notices dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-13), the petitioners have submitted representations dated 29.07.2016 (Annexures P-14 and P-15, respectively) before respondent No.

3. It was urged that the same have not been decided so far.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, perusing the paper-book and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the

controversy, we dispose of this petition at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to take a decision on the representations dated 29.07.2016 (Annexures P-14 and P-15 respectively) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
