The petitioners herein who are five in number are currently serving as Municipal Engineers under the Urban Local Bodies Department, State of Haryana.

The instant petition has been filed seeking a writ of mandamus to direct the official respondents to consider the case for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer and which post is governed by the Haryana Municipal Services Integrated Recruitment and Condition of Service Rules, 2010.

Mr. Amit Jhanji, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has during the course of hearing today very fairly adverted to a letter dated 26.08.2016 appended and placed on record at Annexure P-22 whereby the past 10 years ACRs as also other relevant material has been called for from as many as 26 Municipal Engineers including the present petitioners for purposes of consideration of their claim for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer.

The document at Annexure P-22 would prima facie indicate that the case of the present petitioners is also being considered for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer.

Under such circumstances, there would be no occasion for this Court to pass any directions in the light of a prayer raised in the petition.

Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

It is, however, clarified that it would always be open for the petitioners to approach the Court afresh as regards their claim for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer in the eventuality of any view/order being passed and which may be construed as detrimental to their interest.
