The instant petition was instituted at the hands of three petitioners impugning the methodology being adopted by the respondent/Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Government College , Dabwali, District Sirsa whereby one set of contractual employees was sought to be replaced by another similar arrangement. The petition had come up for preliminary hearing on 30.08.2016 and at that stage itself, petitioner No.1, namely, Beant Kaur had given up her claim and the writ petition qua her was dismissed as withdrawn.

During the course of hearing today, counsel states that even petitioner No.2, namely, Kirandeep Kaur is not pressing her claim and grievance. As per submission made by counsel, the present petition qua petitioner No.3, Kirandeep Kaur is permitted to be withdrawn unconditionally.

Insofar as petitioner No.2, namely, Shiwali is concerned, counsel submits that some other teacher has been engaged on a contractual basis thereby replacing her. Accordingly, prayer has been made for withdrawal of the instant petition qua petitioner No.2, Shiwali with liberty

to file a petition afresh on the same cause of action and by impleading the teacher who has replaced her.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
