Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner was engaged as a part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar under the respondent-Education Department in Panipat district on 6.7.1985. His services have been regularized w.e.f. 14.5.2013.

Counsel submits that private respondent no.4 was also engaged as a part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar in Panipat district at a later point of time i.e. on 3.4.1999, yet, his services have been regularized w.e.f. 1.3.2002.

The instant petition has been filed seeking parity as regards grant of benefit of regularization. Counsel submits that he would be satisfied, if, at this stage, directions are issued to the respondent authorities to consider the claim of the petitioner seeking benefit of ante dated regularization w.e.f. 1.3.2002 in the light of a legal notice dated 21.5.2016 (Annexure P-6) that has already been served.

The present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to consider the claim of the petitioner and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 21.5.2016 (Annexure P-6)

strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition disposed of.
