TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner was appointed on the post of Peon-cum-Chowkidar under the Punjab State Education Department on 26.01.1980. He retired on 31.12.2015 upon attaining the age of superannuation.

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that without any justifiable basis retiral benefits have not been released to him.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner against the backdrop of a representation dated 28.06.2016 (Annexure P-6) having already been made. A final decision on the representation be taken positively within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is further observed that in case the petitioner is held entitled to the admissible retiral benefits, the requisite financial benefits be released to the petitioner forthwith.
