Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus/certiorari.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that case of the petitioner is still pending consideration before the respondent authorities, which was never declined at any point of time.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Director, Department of Industries and Commerce, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one month from today along with relevant material in its favour, grievance of the petitioner shall be considered at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
