This order will dispose of CWP Nos. 19660 of 2014 and 14109 of 2015 as common questions of law and facts are involved therein. However, facts have been extracted from CWP No. 19660 of 2014.

The instant petitions have been filed for prohibiting/restraining respondent No. 2-Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana from demolishing residential houses of the petitioners, without issuing notice.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 states that Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana will pass fresh order, after following due procedure of law, as laid down in the Punjab

Municipal Corporation Act.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for responded No. 2, the present writ petitions are disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana that they should proceed in accordance with law, after providing adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

The writ petitions are disposed of accordingly.
