The petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter-alia* praying for setting aside the allotment of tender dated 17.08.2016 (Annexure P18) issued to respondent No.3 against tender enquiry dated 06.05.2016 for HTC Rohtak by wrongly disqualifying him in technical bid by stating that the original partnership deed dated 06.07.2009 has not been submitted/uploaded during the e-tendering process, whereas, the partnership deed dated 10.03.2011 (Annexure P1) was duly uploaded and also accepted by the respondent-FCI in other tender bids submitted by the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as have been sought to be raised in the present writ petition before the concerned authority within one week from today and decide the same in a time-bound manner.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. However, it is directed that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner within one week from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the same shall be

decided by respondent No.2 within a period of next 7 days thereafter, after affording an opportunity of hearing and by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
