TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

As per pleadings on record, the present petitioner was engaged as a Water Carrier on part time basis in the year 1981 and joined duties in the office of Ayurved Medicine Officer, Incharge G.A.D., Budha Khera, District Jind under the Department of Health Services, State of Haryana. It is sought to be contended that he has worked continuously thereafter and is serving even upto date.

Claim raised in the instant petition is for grant of benefit of regularization under the various policies issued by the State Government on the subject to regularization from time to time.

Without even going into the merits of the case and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments as also submissions made by counsel, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation as regards seeking benefit of regularization and by relying upon the appropriate and relevant policy of regularization. In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, the competent/respondent authority

would be obligated to consider the same strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of six months from the date of submission of such representation.
