SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The petitioner's land is said to have been acquired by the State of Punjab for which Land Acquisition Collector, Abohar passed an award on 02.02.2015 (P2). Alleging that no compensation amount in terms of that award has been paid till date, the petitioner has approached this Court.

(2) Having regard to the nature of relief sought in this writ petition and being satisfied that if the petitioner's land has been acquired in accordance with law, he is entitled to be paid due amount of compensation, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondents No.2&3 to verify the records and if the above-stated plea taken by the petitioner is found correct let the due amount of compensation along with interest be released to him within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
