This order will dispose of CWP Nos. 19747, 19909, 19978, 20104, 24903 and 24921 of 2014, as the issue involved in all the petitions is common.

Affidavit of M. L. Kaushik, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula dated 20.3.2016 filed today in court in CWP No. 19747 of 2014, is taken on record. In the affidavit, it has been stated that the clause in the advertisement requiring “consistent good academic record”, to which the petitioners have grievance has been substituted with a new provision defining the term as “good academic record”.

With the change in the conditions laid down in the advertisement for recruitment to the post of TGT and the State having withdrawn the earlier advertisement requiring “consistent good academic record” and having issued a fresh advertisement substituting “good

academic record” on 28.6.2015, in pursuance to which the petitioners have also applied and the process for selection is in progress, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the prayer made in the present set of petitions has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
