Petitioner-Rajat Baghla had competed against the 198 general category posts out of 500 advertised posts of Clerk-cum-Data Entry Operators pursuant to the advertisement dated 26.09.2015 (P-1). As per the result the petitioner stands at Sr. No.262 of the merit. The candidates till Sr. No.261 have been offered appointment against the 198 posts in the general category.

By filing the present petition, petitioner has impugned the order dated 18.05.2016 (P-10) whereby his claim for appointment has been rejected on the ground that the matter qua appointment in the general category is subjudice in CWP No.21197 of 2014. In the said petition, the candidates belonging to the Backward Class category who are in the waiting list in that category, have prayed for a direction to shift selected candidates

in the BC category to the general category having a better merit position that some of the candidates appointed in the general category.

It is apparent that after the candidates to be so shifted from BC category having higher merit, it is obvious that some of the candidates with lower merit in the general category will get push out to the zone of appointment, therefore, the petitioner cannot claim any Mandamus for his own appointment.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince the court, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
