SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The petitioner after receiving undue amount of compensation of almost ₹95 lacs against due amount of hardly ₹4 lacs, now claims that such excessive compensation was paid to him on the basis of his alleged possession of the joint *khata* land. Since the claim put forth obviously would be prejudicial to the interest of other co-sharers, we decline to entertain this writ petition and dismiss the same with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings by impleading all the co-sharers so that individual entitlement could be determined.

(2) With liberty afore-mentioned, the writ petition stands dismissed.
