Petitioner-Karamjeet Kaur was an aspirant for engagement as an Anganwadi Worker in village Bhugran, Tehsil Dhuri, District Amritsar in the year 2011. The selection was finalized on 3.7.2011, whereby Sarabjit Kaur-respondent no.3 was placed at number 01 of the merit and the petitioner at number 01 of the waiting list. Soon after the appointment of the respondent no.3 in July 2011, the petitioner had made a complaint regarding forged and fabricated documents submitted by Sarabjit Kaur for seeking her appointment. It is claimed that the said Sarabjit Kaur now has resigned on 29.06.2016 during a preliminary enquiry with regard to the complaint submitted by the petitioner and, therefore, the post having become vacant, the petitioner is reviving her right of appointment.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for interference is made out. The waiting list cannot remain operative for years

together. The post having become vacant is liable to be re-advertised keeping in view the interest of the other eligible candidates as well. The petitioner would have full opportunity to compete again.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
