JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

National Rural Health Mission, Punjab, vide advertisement dated 18.01.2014 (**Annexure P-2**) advertised *inter alia* 335 posts of Pharmacists at a consolidated salary of Rs. 10,000/- per month, out of which thirteen (13) posts were advertised in the category of Ex-Servicemen. The written test was held on 25.05.2014 and as per the result declared on 10.07.2014 (**Annexure P-4**), two (02) Ex-Servicemen (as also Scheduled Castes) were short listed against thirteen (13) advertised posts.

Prayer of the petitioner is for directing respondent Nos. 3 & 4 to fill-up eleven (11) vacant posts of Pharmacists (as per advertisement **P-2**) in the category of Scheduled Castes, Ex-Servicemen from the Lineal Descendent of Scheduled Castes Ex-Servicemen and consider the case of

the petitioner in the said category in the light of certificate of “Lineal Descendent Certificate (Scheduled Castes)” in his favour.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3 & 4 submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of affidavit submitted by the petitioner in the office of respondents.

In view of statement of learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3 & 4, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
