The petitioner is seeking direction to protect her son from custodial/inhuman torture after remand on account of FIRs registered in various districts in the State of Punjab.

It is not disputed that the petitioner is in custody in FIR No.47 dated 7.4.2016 under Sections 302, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station, Dugri District Ludhiana and is main accused having fired two gun shots upon the deceased Vikrant @ Vicky. If the petitioner has any grievance regarding the issue of mal-treatment or any torture, he has remedy to file an application before the concerned Court under the Code of Criminal Procedure.

In such circumstances, no such direction can be issued as it would amount to hampering the investigation of serious offences for which the role of the accused is being looked into.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
