Learned Law Officer makes a statement that the case of the petitioner is under active consideration of the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana on a clarification sought by the department where the period from 22.1.2004 to 24.10.2005 has to be counted towards experience gained by the petitioner. Ms. Goyal has received a memo dated 28.11.2016 from the Office of the Principal Secretary to Government Haryana, Environment Department, addressed to the Advocate General Haryana informing him to further inform this Court that the matter is under active consideration at the highest level of Government but the same is likely to take some more time.

In para 5 of the memo it has been mentioned that advice sought by the Environment Department, the Chief Secretary office has already been answered positively as under:-

“AD is advised that the period of (1 year, 8 months and 2 weeks) is to be counted for the purpose of promotion since he has worked on the post of Scientist Grade-I and has also drawn the salary for the said period.”

A copy of the said memo is taken on record as mark 'A.

In view of this position, it would be of no use to keep this matter pending and the same can be disposed of with the direction to the competent-authority to take a final decision within 6 weeks. After the decision is taken, the consequential benefits may be given to the petitioner as per his entitlement and in accordance with law.

The matter stands disposed of with the above observations and the directions and in terms of the memo produced today by the learned Law Officer.
