RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

In compliance of the order dated 25.07.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the State submits that minus the affidavit of respondent No.2, the action is complete at the site. Appropriate order dated 07.11.2016 has been passed by Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka and copy thereof along with photographs, as Annexures R-1 and R-2, produced before the Court, are taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Gurdas Singh, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Fazilka, submits that since the

appropriate action has been taken and order dated 07.11.2016 has been passed, nothing remains to be decided in the present writ petition at the hands of this Court and the writ petition may be ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners also fairly states that let the present writ petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, but liberty may be granted to the petitioners to pursue their other remedies, if any, before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law.

In view of the abovesaid respective fair stands taken by learned counsel for the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, with liberty as prayed for.

Disposed of, accordingly.
