TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner was engaged as a part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar under the respondent-Education Department on 01.01.1992. Her services have been regularized in terms of order dated 24.06.2013 but w.e.f. 01.04.2011.

Counsel submits that private respondent No.4-Azad Singh son of Shri Deep Singh and who was also identically engaged but subsequent in point of time i.e. on 03.04.1999 has been granted benefit of regularization w.e.f. 01.03.2002.

Instant petition has been filed seeking parity of treatment and to be granted ante-dated benefit of regularization and w.e.f. 01.03.2002. Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if at this stage directions are issued to the respondent/Authorities to consider the claim of the petitioner in the light of legal notice dated 21.05.2016 at Annexure P-6 that has already been served.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent

No. 3 to consider the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law

and by passing a speaking order on the legal notice dated 21.05.2016 at Annexure P-6 within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
