The controversy involved in this case, in short, is that the 'Jan Aushadhi Store', situated in the premises of Civil Hospital, Moga, has to be run by the Punjab Health Systems Corporation and District Red Cross Society, Moga under the chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner, Moga.

Counsel for respondent No. 3 has informed the Court that already the services of Gurpreet Singh(respondent No. 11) and Pardeep Kumar(respondent No. 12) have been dispensed with and the 'Jan Aushadhi Store' situated in the premises of

Civil Hospital, Moga is now being run by the Red Cross Society under the direct supervision of the Deputy Commissioner, Moga and is not being run by any other person.

In view of the statement made by counsel for respondent No. 3, present petition is hereby disposed of.
