1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to respondent No. 2 to allot alternative plot in the scheme under which the land of the petitioner was acquired or in any other equally developed scheme in which the plots are still available, instead of plot No. 786-F, Shahid Bhagat Singh Nagar Development Scheme.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the petitioner has not approached respondent No. 2 for the relief claimed in this writ petition, the instant petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before respondent No. 2 raising all the pleas as have been

sought to be raised herein. Further a prayer has been made that direction be issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation in a time bound manner in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition before respondent No. 2 within a period of one month from today. It is directed that in the event of filing such representation by the petitioner within the stipulated period, the same shall be decided by respondent No. 2 within next three months, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
