Application for placing on record Annexures R-2/4 to R-2/8, filed by the applicant-respondents No.2 to 4, is allowed. Same are taken on record. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

Main case

Petitioner has challenged the order dated 13.08.2015 (Annexure P11) whereby she was shown as reappear candidate in the subject of Digital Electronic EE-2004-F in the B.Tech 4th semester course. Resultantly, she was requested to return the Detailed Marks Certificate, which had been issued on 20.09.2012 and was asked to reappear in the next examination, as per schedule. Petitioner had approached this Court on the ground that thereafter, she was pursuing the course of Masters of Technology and the said communication was after 3 years. She had been allowed to pursue her course, subject to final decision of the case.

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In the response filed by the respondent-University, it is pleaded that due to wrong mentioning of the roll numbers, the marks were wrongly recorded and the correction had been made to the students and the said result was uploaded in the web-portal. The admission in the M.Tech course had been made wrongly by the College, without getting the consolidated DMC of the 8th semester.

Vide order dated 22.08.2016, these facts were noted and accordingly, a direction had been issued that the respondent-University will take a decision to give a special opportunity to the petitioner to appear in the reappear examination of the above-said subject. Vide Annexure R-2/4, now placed on record, the petitioner was asked to fill up the examination form and accordingly, had sat in the reappear subjects and had passed. The DMC dated 21.10.2016 (Annexure R-2/8) had also been issued, accordingly.

Resultantly, keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed of. Petitioner shall return the earlier DMC issued to her on 20.09.2012.
