As per office report, notices issued to respondents No. 1 and 2 have not been received back either served or otherwise.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4, on instructions from Sardar Arvinderjt Singh, Manager, Axis Bank, Sector-34-A, Chandigarh, submits that in compliance of the order dated 9.9.2016 passed by this Court, petitioner has deposited the amount of Rs.1 lac with the respondent-Bank and has cleared due Equated Monthly Installments ('EMI' for short) up-to date. He further submits that if the petitioner gives an undertaking by moving an appropriate application to the respondent-Bank within a period of one week from today that he will keep on paying the EMI in time in future, respondent No.4 shall return the vehicle to the petitioner forthwith and shall also regularise his loan account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instruction from the petitioner, who is present in the Court, fairly states that the above-said proposal put forth by learned counsel for respondent No.4 is acceptable to the petitioner as well.

In view of the above-said respective stands taken by learned counsel for the contesting parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.4, by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one week from today, which shall be considered and decided by respondent No.4 at an early date and in any case within a period of one week after the receipt of application from the petitioner. Respondent No.4 shall also hand over the vehicle in question to the petitioner without any further loss of time.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
