Petitioner before this Court is seeking issuance of a direction to the respondents to adopt the reservation policy for allotment of L.P.G dealership in Batala.

Learned counsel for the respondents at the very outset submitted that the petitioner is living in Australia and the present petition has been filed through a power of attorney holder. The written statement was filed in March 2013, to which no replication has been filed till date.

When the petitioner is living in Australia and the petition is filed through Power of Attorney holder, no case is made out for interference in a case seeking allotment of a LPG agency at Batala.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
