Petitioner, who is a minor, has approached this Court through his father, for correction of his date of birth as 25.02.1999 in place of 25.11.1999. Reliance has been placed upon the birth certificate (Annexure P1), which is registered on 26.02.1999 (as per the photocopy of the vernacular of Annexure P1/T).

It is the case of the petitioner that he is entitled for the necessary correction and a representation dated 01.08.2016 (Annexure P4) has already been filed with the respondents.

Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the same is decided within a time-bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.N.K.Setia, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-Board.

Keeping in view the fact that the decision making is still to be finalized as the representation has only been filed recently, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

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Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondent-Board to decide the representation dated 01.08.2016 (Annexure P4), within a period of 2 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. The respondent-Board shall also take into consideration the observations made by the Division Bench of this Court in **Resham Singh Vs. Union of India & another 2008 (1) SCT 11** and **Ambika Kaul Vs. Central Board of Secondary Education 2015 (3) SCT 350**.
