Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners approached the respondent authorities by way of representation dated 25.6.2016 (Annexure P-4). However when they were asked to substantiate their allegations levelled in the complaint by issuing the communication dated 27.7.2016 (Annexure P-5), petitioners are trying to backtrack from the complaint. If that is so, petitioners have no case either on facts or in law. Once they have moved the complaint levelling serious allegations, they are supposed to substantiate their allegation. Only that is what has been asked from the petitioners by the respondent authorities. If the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the complaint, it is their choice.

In view of the above-said undisputed fact situation obtaining in the present case, instant one has not been found to be a fit case enabling this Court to exercise its extraordinary writ jurisdiction. No case for interference has been made out.

Dismissed.
