The petitioner by way of this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP in the revised ACP scales as per Rules alongwith interest @ 18 % per annum.

I have carefully gone through the file of the present writ petition.

It comes out that respondent No. 2 has been served with the representation/legal notice dated 25.02.2014 (*Annexure P-2*) with regard to grant of 1st and 2nd ACP after completion of 10 and 20 years of service respectively as per the revised scale w.e.f. 01.01.2006.

The present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforementioned representation/legal notice dated 25.02.2014 (*Annexure P-2*) of the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
