Surya Kant, J. (Oral):

Learned counsel for the UT Administration has placed on record the order dated 10th March, 2016, whereby, Executive Engineer, Project P.H. Division No.7, Chandigarh has declared the deceased husband of the petitioner to be a regular employee and consequently the petitioner entitled to seek family pension and other retiral benefits in accordance with the rules. He has also placed on record the letter dated 22nd March, 2016 whereby the Executive Engineer has forwarded the case for grant of family pension to the petitioner to the Accountant General (A&E), UT Chandigarh.

In this view of the matter, nothing survives in this case for adjudication except to direct the authorities, including the Accountant General (A&E), UT Chandigarh, to complete the process and issue the

Pension Payment Order (PPO) as early as possible but not later than three months.

Disposed of accordingly.
