Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.6 is the only contesting respondent and service upon the remaining private respondents may be dispensed with, at this stage. Ordered accordingly.

Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 24.07.2015

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(Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1-Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that revision (Annexure P-3) is pending before respondent No.2-Commissioner, Faridkot Division, Faridkot, but the same is not being decided.

Learned counsel for respondent No.6 states that he has no objection if the impugned order dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) whereby direction has been issued to get the partition orders implemented within two months, is set aside.

In view of the consent given by learned counsel for respondent No.6, who is the main contenting respondent, the impugned order dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) is set aside and respondent No.2 is directed to decide the revision pending before him within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The respondents and other affected persons may be given notice by way of *munadi*/proclamation, if not already served.

Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
