Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court for correction of date of birth which has wrongly been mentioned as '30.12.1997' instead of '30.11.1997' in Grade Sheet-cum-Certificate of Performance of Secondary School Examination (Sessions 2012-14), issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education (Annexure P-5).

In support of the plea that there being some error in mentioning the date of birth, learned counsel for the petitioner referred to birth certificate (Annexure P-1), application for admission (Annexure P-2), transfer certificate issued by the school (Annexure P-3) and registration -cum- admission form (Annexure P-4), all mentioning date of birth as 30.11.1997. Immediately after receipt of the certificate and noticing the error, application was filed by the petitioner to the school to get the same corrected. It was mentioned therein that at the time of online filling of form of Class-X, inadvertently incorrect month was entered i.e. December instead of November. The case of the petitioner was even recommended by the school to the Board for carrying out necessary correction.

Learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 and 2 fairly submitted that in the light of the documents produced on record by the petitioner, the matter shall be reconsidered and the necessary correction in the date of birth

shall be carried out and thereafter corrected certificate shall be issued to the petitioner.

The needful shall be done within a period of four weeks from today.

The petition stands disposed of.
