The petitioner seeks a writ of certiorari to quash a notice dated 24.07.2015 terminating the agreement under which the petitioner was running a chemist shop in the premises of the respondent.

2. By virtue of several interim orders, the period of licence has come to an end by efflux of time. The petitioner has admittedly vacated and handed over quiet, vacant and peaceful possession of the premises to the respondent. This is confirmed by both the parties.

3. The petitioner is always at liberty to make an application for extension. The respondent will consider the same. It is clarified that this order and all other orders passed in this writ petition are without prejudice to the rights, contentions of the parties including the respondent's rights to claim any further amount from the petitioner.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
