The prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing the impugned order dated 12.07.2016 **(Annexure P-10)** passed by respondent No.1 vide which the petitioner-Bank was directed to vacate the premises in dispute by 20.09.2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the affidavit furnished by the authorized officer of the petitioner-Bank i.e. Sh. Alok Jain, Chief Manager, Punjab National Bank, Plot No.11, Industrial Area, Phase-II, Chandigarh on September 20, 2016, wherein it was stated that the property in dispute shall be vacated within three months, the Bank has shifted to another premises and has vacated the property in dispute i.e. the part of Plot No.11, Industrial Area Phase-II, Chandigarh.

3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the parties state that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
