KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner claims that her husband, namely, Baldev Singh, who was working as a Constable No. 1166 with Punjab Police in Police Station Majitha, died in harness on 27.2.2011. He was survived by the petitioner, two sons and one daughter. However, the service benefits have not been released to her despite legal notice dated 16.2.2015 (Annexure-P-5).

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Amritsar-respondent No. 2 herein, to pass a speaking order on the legal notice dated 16.2.2015 (Annexure-P-5) as to whether the petitioner is entitled to the service benefits of deceased

CWP No. 19429 of 2016 (O/M)

Constable Baldev Singh No. 1166, who died in harness. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled to service benefits of her husband, the same be released to her forthwith within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, failing which a detailed reasoning be given, declining the said benefit.
