Feeling aggrieved against the impugned orders dated 02.08.2016 (Annexure P-9) and 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-8), whereby petitioner has been asked to vacate the govt. accommodation allotted to him, he has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned orders.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this petition on merits at this stage. He further submits that petitioner shall approach the competent authority who is Inspector General, HQ North West Frontier Indo-Tibetan Boarder Police Force, Behlana, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, by moving an appropriate representation within a period of two weeks from today and he may be directed to consider the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without

expressing any opinion on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, impugned orders dated 02.08.2016 (Annexure P-9) and 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-8) are upheld, however, Inspector General, HQ North West Frontier Indo-Tibetan Boarder Police Force, Behlana, Chandigarh-respondent No.3 is directed that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation within a period of two weeks from today, he shall look into the grievance raised by the petitioner in his representation and shall decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, at an early date but in any case within a period of six weeks after the receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
