TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Pleadings on record would indicate that petitioner No.1 joined services with the Nagar Council, Sangrur under the aegis of Department of Local Government Punjab as Clerk in the year 1985. He retired on 30.04.2016 upon attaining the age of superannuation. Likewise, petitioner No.2 joined as Safai Karmchari under the same employer and retired on 30.11.2015.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that the complete retiral benefits have not been released to the petitioners and without any justifiable basis.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.4/competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 17.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) i.e. stated to have already been served and a final decision thereupon be taken and a speaking order be passed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is further observed that in case the petitioners are found

entitled to the balance retiral benefits, the requisite financial benefits be released to them forthwith.
