In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has questioned the order dated 27.04.2016 passed by the disciplinary authority by which 3 annual increments of the petitioner have been stopped with cumulative effect and further ordered for recovery of Rs.2,44,949/- from the petitioner's monthly salary. The petitioner has availed the alternative remedy of appeal before the appellate authority on 10.05.2016.

2. In view of filing and pendency of the appeal before the appellate authority, the petitioner cannot have parallel proceedings. Therefore, appellate authority seems to be His Excellency Governor. The appellate authority is requested to consider interim prayer within a period of 2 months from today, thereafter, appeal be disposed of within a period of 6 months from today.
