Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari directing the respondents to consider his claim and allow him to join existing pension scheme under the Employees Pension Regulations, 1995.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for redressal of his grievance, petitioner had served notice dated 17.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) on the respondents, but no action has been taken on the same so far.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.1 to dispose of the notice Annexure P-6 served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
