M.JEYAPPAUL, J.

Learned counsel for the writ petitioner submits that a fresh reservation roster was already prepared and placed on record before the Tribunal but the Tribunal failed to take note of the fresh reservation roster so placed on record.

It is found that the Tribunal has in fact passed an order directing the writ petitioner herein to prepare fresh reservation roster and consider the candidature of respondents No.1 and 2 against any vacancy that had arisen, if at all, they were also found eligible.

As it is brought to our notice that a fresh reservation roster was already placed on record before the Ld. Tribunal, the writ

petition stands dismissed as withdrawn as prayed for by the counsel for writ petitioner with liberty to the writ petitioner to move a necessary application for review on the basis of fresh reservation roster which was already placed on record before it.

Ld. Tribunal shall take cognizance of the review application, if any, filed by the writ petitioner without advertting to the point of limitation.
