After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that the instant writ petition is totally misconceived and premature. The process of re-demarcation of the boundaries of the village is underway to which the petitioners are objecting to.

In these circumstances, the petitioners would have a cause of grievance in case their objections are dismissed or if the land of the village to which they belong is altered to the detriment of the residents of the village. Since no prejudice manifests itself from the petition, the same is without any merit and is dismissed leaving the petitioners to their remedies in law.
