JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

The father of the petitioner was working as a Peon in the Tehsildar Office, Rampura Phul, District Bathinda. He superannuated on attaining the age of 60 years on 31.12.2014 and thus retired. His services however vide order dated 31.10.2014 were extended for a period of one year commencing w.e.f. 1.1.2015 to 31.12.2015 vide order P-2. He during his extended period died a natural death on 14.03.2015. The prayer of the petitioner is thus for issuing a direction to the respondents to consider his case for compassionate appointment.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner has failed to show any instructions providing for compassionate appointment of a dependent of a employee who has died after his retirement during his extended period of service, which is entirely different from his normal period of service. It is not in dispute that during the extended period the

employees are neither entitled to promotion nor any increment and thus conferring no substantial rights upon such employees.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
