Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No. 2 to pay enhanced interest @ 24 % per annum.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper-book.

Perusal of the impugned award dated 27.05.2015 (Annexure P-5) reveals that interest @ 9 % per annum has been granted to the petitioner from 30.05.2005, which is more than the interest payable even on the fixed deposit.

In view of above, no ground is made out for interference in the impugned award dated 27.05.2015 and payment of interest at enhanced rate.

Dismissed.
