Feeling aggrieved against the numerous impugned resolutions (Annexures P-13 to P-17), petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for quashing the impugned resolutions.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is not in dispute that petitioner has got an equally efficacious alternative remedy against the impugned resolutions under the relevant provisions of Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984 ('the Act of 1984' for short), and statutory rules made thereunder. It is also not disputed that
