S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

The petitioner has challenged the eligibility of respondents No.3 and 4 to be allotted flats pursuant to a brochure issued by the Housing Board, Haryana, offering 54 EWS flats at Gurgaon. There is a reservation for Haryana State Government Employees. The question is whether Anganwari Workers fall within this category.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the official respondents states that the official respondents do not consider the eligibility at the time of draw of lots and that they take the decision regarding the eligibility only after the result of the draw of lots. It is therefore not necessary to entertain this writ petition, at this stage.

The rights of the petitioner and the private respondents are yet to

be determined by the official respondents.

The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the official respondents to take a decision regarding the eligibility of respondents No.3 and 4 before taking a final decision regarding the allotment. Needless to add that the allotment and the possession would depend upon the decision taken by the official respondents. The decision shall not be acted upon for a period of four weeks after the same is taken.
