1. The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated 15.10.2014 (**Annexure P-2**) passed by respondent No.2, vide which allotment of Goods Booking Agency No.38 measuring 538 sq. yards in the development scheme of Transport Nagar, Bathinda, allotted to the petitioner and his associates in the auction held on 09.05.2012 has been cancelled illegally as well as to the order dated 10.06.2016 (**Annexure P-8**) whereby the Additional Chief Secretary, Local Government Department, Punjab has dismissed the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 15.10.2014 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently certain relevant facts have not been incorporated and relevant documents could not be appended along with the present

writ petition. He prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action by incorporating all the necessary facts as well as by appending all the necessary documents.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.
