Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioners herein, who are four in number, were engaged as Extension Lecturers in different subjects in the Govt. College, Bahadurgarh.

The instant petition has been filed raising a grievance that the college has issued an advertisement at Annexure P-1 (date nil) and in pursuance to which interviews have been conducted on 19.7.2016 and now the petitioners would be replaced by another similar arrangement by engaging Extension Lecturers on contractual basis.

During the course of arguments two vital and relevant aspects have been conceded by the counsel. Counsel has very fairly stated that the petitioners otherwise are not eligible as they do not possess the requisite qualifications for the post in question and as prescribed by the U.G.C./State Govt. It has also been conceded that the petitioners have participated in the interview that was conducted on 19.7.2016 in pursuance to the advertisement at Annexure P-1 but till date no Extension Lecturer in respect of the subjects concerning the petitioners have been engaged.

Under such circumstances there would be no basis and occasion for this court to intervene at this stage. It would always be open for the respondent college to engage other Extension Lecturers and on contractual basis and from amongst the candidates, who otherwise are eligible and possess the requisite qualifications. The grievance and cause of action, if any, would accrue to the petitioners only in the eventuality of the respondent college replacing the petitioners by another set of contractual Extension Lecturers who are also not qualified. Such eventuality and situation has not arisen at the moment.

No basis for intervention, as such, is made out, at this stage.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
