The petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide appropriate system for draining out the sullage water of village Sandhaye, Tehsil Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar which has accumulated in the agricultural field of the petitioner and causing not only infertility of the land but also acute health problem to the entire village.

In preliminary objections it is averred that the Gram Panchayat Sandhay(respondent NO. 4) has prepared the estimate for drainage of sullage water to the village pond for which an amount of ₹ 5 lacs is required for construction of drainage system. It is further submitted that the drainage system can be provided

only after receiving the grant from the State Government.

On the last date of hearing, the District Development & Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar was directed to be present in Court. Consequently, Gagandeep Singh, District Development & Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar is present in Court and has submitted that the problem of accumulation of water in the field of the petitioner can be solved if the State Government would sanction ₹ 5 lacs for the purpose of construction of drainage system.

State counsel prays for an adjournment to seek instructions in this regard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances emerging from the record, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the State Government i.e. Department of Development and Panchayat to take a decision regarding grant of ₹ 5 lacs within a period of a week from today and DDPO who is present in Court is further directed to execute the work immediately after the receipt of the grant.
