Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

Gajjan Singh, husband of the petitioner was working as BDPO and posted at Sangat Mandi, District Bathinda, where he died in harness on 10.11.2011.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the retiral benefits of her husband have not been released to her. The short prayer pressed at the time of the arguments is that the respondents may be directed to decide legal notice dated 14.8.2016 (Annexure P2).

In the circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 14.8.2016 (Annexure P2) within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. If the respondents decide that the petitioner is entitled to all or any of the benefits, such benefits be released to her within one month of the passing this order.
