Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 09.09.2016 (Annexure P-13) passed by Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Nabha, District Patiala-respondent No.4, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is gone undisputed before this Court that against the impugned order, petitioners have got equally efficacious remedy of statutory appeal under the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961. It is also not in dispute that before filing the present writ petition, petitioners did not avail their remedy of statutory appeal.

In view of the above, petitioners are relegated to their equally efficacious alternative remedy of statutory appeal, at the first instance.

With the abovesaid observations made, present writ petition stands disposed of.
