RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the zimni order dated 21.06.2016 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services)-respondent No.1, petitioner-Corporation has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, coupled with the fact that impugned order is only a zimni order, he does not intend to press this petition on merits at this stage. However, he submits that the learned Permanent Lok Adalat may be directed to take up immediately the application moved by the petitioner (Annexure P-11), seeking early hearing of the petition or at least pass appropriate directions against respondent No.2 to pay the undisputed amount on account of electricity charges.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without

expressing any opinion on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to learned Permanent Lok Adalat-respondent No.1 to take up the application (Annexure P-11) already moved by the petitioner without any further loss of time and pass an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, by issuing appropriate directions to the consumer-respondent No.2 to pay at least the undisputed amount on account of electricity charges. Let the appropriate order be passed at an early date and in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
